Once registered with a GP group, patients will be entitled to see any GP within their registered group.

GPs will be working towards developing their own policies with regards to the following: -

- Improved access to GPs and nurses
- Better communication with Hospital and other services
- Standardisation of treatments
- Improved repeat prescription systems
- Enhanced nurse roles

We expect that this will improve access to a GP or Nurse of choice, and that standardisation of practice will lead to more efficient and more effective management of long term diseases like Diabetes, Heart Diseases, etc.,
