NEW COVID-19 RULES FOR TRAVELLING TO ENGLAND

From **4am on Monday 17th May 2021** the rules on travelling to England are changing. There will be a new green list of countries and Gibraltar is on the green list. This means: -

Before you travel to England you must: -

- [complete a passenger locator form](#)
- [take a COVID-19 test](#)
- [book and pay for a day 2 COVID-19 test](#)

On arrival in England you must: -

- [take a COVID-19 test](#) on or before day 2 after you arrive. This will be arranged for you by Calpe House.
- you do not need to quarantine unless the test result is positive.
- you must self-isolate only if NHS Test & Trace informs you that you travelled to England with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

THESE RULES COMES INTO EFFECT FROM 4AM ON MONDAY 17TH MAY 2021

Please note if you travel to England before 17th May you must follow the rules for travelling from a country on the amber list.

Please also note that **from Monday 17th May**, if you have also been in or through a country on the amber list ie; Spain, in the 10 days before you arrive in England, you must follow the amber list rules which are as follows:-

- [complete a passenger locator form](#)
- [take a COVID-19 test](#) prior to flying
- [book and pay for day 2 and day 8 COVID-19 travel tests](#) – to be taken after arrival in England
- on arrival in England you must quarantine at home or in the place you are staying for 10 days
- take a COVID-19 test on or before day 2 and on or after day 8
- you may be able to end quarantine early if you pay for a private COVID-19 test through the Test to Release Scheme. This can be arranged by Calpe House.
